

## Reading Fiction — Grade 4

Each day you should read for at least 60 minutes and journal about your thinking.

Remember to think about your reading as you read. Don't just read and forget. The fiction goals a 4th grader are working on are; Writing a summary, analyzing parts of a narrative, analyzing character's traits, analyzing how character's change and analyzing themes. Working on these goals will prepare you for 5th grade and beyond.

1. Study the daily reading goal. This is what you are thinking about as you read.
2. Read 1 chapter of your book. Look for your reading goal in the chapter.
3. Stop and journal. Answer the daily journal questions.
4. Keep reading for the remainder of the hour or longer if you want.
