[Google Classroom](#) - all learning will take place through the Google Classroom platform. The username is the student's individual suffieldstudent.org account.

[College Board](#) - Unique Username and password ask set up by the student. If no username and password, contact guidance for help in setting this up.

[AP Classroom](#) - Organized by the college board, and run by each individual AP teacher, a collection of resources, released items, in progress checks with the AP curriculum. Each individual AP teacher has signed up their students through the AP

classroom. Practices are online as webinars or as videos you can check out when you have time. The username and password is the same as the College Board username and password.

Pearson ebooks - textbooks for the math and science departments that are available online are to be accessed through the PowerSchool portal. Students already know how to do this.

Khan Academy - SAT and PSAT practice for students, as well as curricular content for many core subjects. The login is the same as the College Board login. Although the SAT tests are canceled this spring, they will still happen in summer and fall of next year. So you can keep practicing to make sure you have the highest score possible when you do take it.

NoRedInk — Writing and grammar instruction with immediate feedback. Builds stronger writers through interest-based curriculum, adaptive exercises and actionable data. CommonLit: Teachers give the students a code to sign up. This is a place for literature and nonfiction reading with assessments teachers can use to gauge student learning.

FlipGrid: A platform that allows teachers to engage and empower every voice in the classroom or at home by recording and sharing short, awesome videos. The teacher invites the student with a code for the class and they connect with their suffieldstudent.org account.

Nearpod: The teacher will give you a lesson code in order to join a lesson. Nearpod is an instructional platform that merges formative assessment and dynamic media for collaborative learning experiences.

US History Online Textbook: Students have individual usernames and passwords that the teacher has helped them set up.
