1. From the LPISD student website, access the link for HMH Ed for the online textbook.
2. Student's log in is their district specific username and password.
3. **Day 1:** Go to the *Assignments* tab and CHOOSE ONE of the following stories to read: *Batting After Sophie* OR *Amigo Brothers*.
4. Complete the *Selection Test* for the story you chose to read. (There will be a preview of the tests on Teams so you can look over the questions before you read)
5. Click *Submit* to turn in the assignment.
6. **Day 2:** Go to the *Assignments* tab in HMH and complete the *Writing Task* activity.
7. Be sure to click on the links within the activity to watch the videos for help with your writing assignment.

I suggest you start your writing in a word document and then transfer it. Your writing assignment is supposed to be automatically saved by the HMH program as you work, but sometimes technology doesn't work.
