u	□ Don't have a computer or tablet? No problem, ALA can help! Contact your campus' front office to borrow an ALA Chromebook and arrange pick-up. Please note, we have limited devices and we want to make sure these are available to those families that do not have access to an internet connected device at home.
	Locate your student's ALA email address and password:  -Log in to your Infinite Campus Parent Portal  -Click "More"  -Click "Technology Access"  -Student email and password will be displayed.
	Beginning March 27, teachers will send a link/classroom code along with instructions on how to log in to Google Classroom. <a href="Invitations will be sent directly to your student's ALA email account.">Invitations will be sent directly to your student's ALA email account.</a> Didn't receive an invitation? No problem! Please contact your child's teacher directly and he/she will resend the link/classroom code.
	Students will access Google Classroom using their Clever account.  Login instructions can be found <u>HERE</u> .
	Establish a time of day and quiet place to work on assignments. At this time, assignments are accessible to students any time of day and can be completed around your family's schedule.
	Teachers will provide feedback on completed assignments directly to students.
	Although grades will not be recorded/posted <u>at this time</u> , students are strongly encouraged to participate in daily lessons to the very best of their ability.
	Teachers will check in with students by phone on a weekly basis.
