The following, outlines important information that may affect your scholar(s) beginning April 1, 2020:

- Grab and Go Breakfast and Lunches will be available every weekday for all scholars in need beginning Wednesday, April 1st from 8am-12pm, at Pine Bluff Lighthouse, Capital City Lighthouse, and Jacksonville Main and College Preparatory campuses.
- AMI Instruction will resume March 30, 2020. All scholars with access to technology should check their school email for *Google Classroom*[™] invites from their teachers. AMI instruction will be available via *Google Classroom*[™].
- All scholars who **do not** have access to technology may pick up packets on April 1st at each school from 11am-6pm. *****Flightline Upper Academy scholars will pick up packets at Jacksonville Lighthouse Charter School Mike Wilson Athletic Center at 251. N First Street.**
- Thank you to those scholars who have been submitting their work to teachers via email or online. Those of you who need to turn in your completed paper packets may do so by dropping them off at your campus in the foyer of the building April 1st from 11 am and 6 pm. It is IMPORTANT that you include your NAME and teacher's name on every paper.
- If scholars are having problems accessing their student email accounts or *Google Classroom*[™], please reach out to your scholar's teacher for assistance.
- Finally, all medication will be available for pick-up on April 1st and April 3rd from 11am-6pm. If your scholar has medication that has been with the school nurse, please pick it up on these dates.
