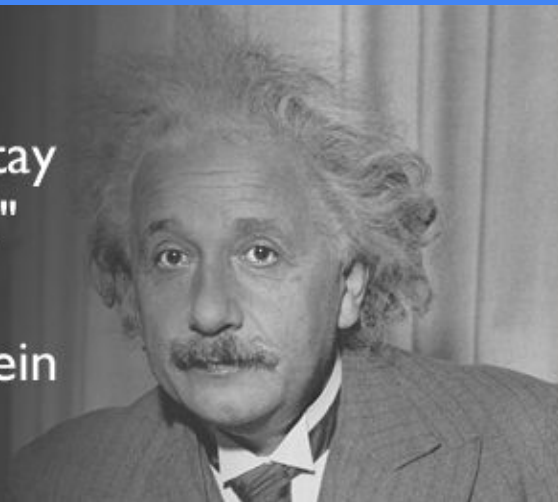

Dreambox is an online math learning program that is designed to address learning across standards even from previous grade levels.



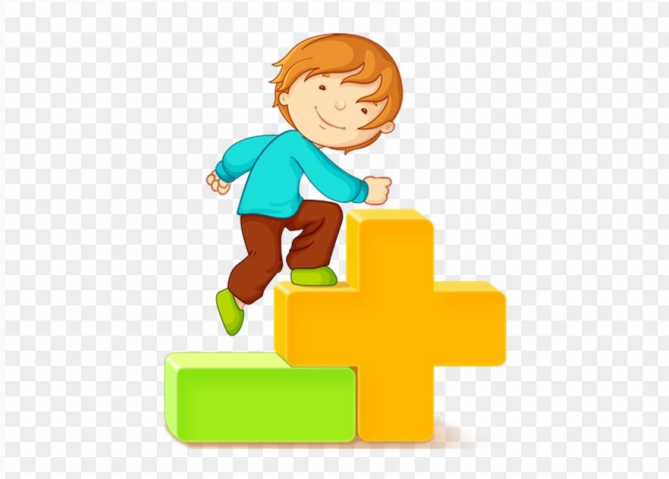
Individualized Learning

Students will be assigned lessons from all math domains appropriate to their grade level.

- Geometry
- Measurement and Data
- Numbers Base Ten (Understanding Quantity and Place Value)
- Operations (Add, Subtract, Multiply and Divide)

Parents want to help their child, so do teachers, but with Dreambox it is important to let your child work independently and struggle through the challenging stuff.

Dreambox analyzes the students every click and pause and will adjust the lessons accordingly. It will give the students the lessons they need to deeply understand the math.

Recommended Usage

- 5 or more completed lessons per week is the goal.
- Once students choose a lesson, they must stick with it until completion. They should not leave the lesson just because it is difficult.
- Encourage students to make good guesses if it is too difficult - this will allow dreambox to adjust to the appropriate level.

Additional Information to help your child succeed

- Headphones will help your child to hear the directions and tips and also help them to concentrate on Dreambox.
- Students can and should pause Dreambox with the pause button on the top right corner of the screen if they need to take a break.
- Dreambox will also provide challenges above grade level for students who are mastering the standards in their grade level so they will continue to have more learning if needed!
