Reading-Read 20 minutes aloud to a parent each day. Record the book title that you read.

Poetry- Read the poem <u>Hurt No Living Thing</u>--1. underline all of the uppercase letters, highlight or underline with a colored pencil/crayon all the animal/creature words, circle any rhyming words, and draw a picture to go with the poem.

Math-Continuing practicing telling time, using the clock to tell time to the hour and half hour, writing your numbers and locating them from a 200 chart, and adding and subtracting numbers to 20. Please complete one of the worksheets provided to give you additional practice.

Writing-Finish working on your animal to research. Learn what they look like (characteristics), what they eat, and where they live. Write down what you've learned using complete sentences. Make sure you have headings, introduce the topic, and have a closing statement.

Art/Science-Make a cover for your animal report and color it. Practice reading the report at home and be ready to present your report to the class. You'll be standing up telling your classmates about your animal and what you've learned.
