Hello there,

As you may know, Utah Gov. Gary Herbert issued a directive to the State of Utah late this afternoon regarding the movement and activities of individuals and families as we work together to curb the spread of COVID-19.


Gov. Herbert's directive, which is in place until 11:59 p.m. April 13, 2020, is attached to this email.

The directive does not change the current procedures we are following in the Davis School District. After Spring Break, the district will continue to provide education to all of its students through remote learning and digital instruction. Gov. Herbert's earlier "soft closure" directive as it relates to schools is still in place until May 1, 2020.


The district will also continue to provide "Grab and Go" meals following Spring Break to individuals ages 1-18 Monday through Friday from 11-12:30 p.m. at its schools.
