We are very grateful that Teaching and Learning department was there to give us a clear idea about how BSD and Teaching and Learning can both work together to finally decide where Summa would be best fit for the kids. We understand that final decision regarding Summa location will be taken by Teaching and Learning but it will certainly depend on the capacity of the school and currently BSD's main goal is to address that issue. As mentioned by Teaching and Learning one Summa is more effective both cost and quality wise and the class learning experience for the kids is also more, hence we strongly urge BSD to make every effort towards capacity optimization in Timberland so that entire North Summa can be there not only in 2021 but long term. Per my understanding on the guesstimate of Summa numbers and the current capacity of Timberland, there needs to be some adjustment to the working map of 3/12/20. Here are the options that we can look at:1) Move entire Oak Hills E to Stoller and they feed into Sunset with Jacob Wisemer.- Distance between Oak Hills E to Stoller is less than that of Timberland. Ideally Stoller is the neighborhood school for Oak Hills not Timberland.2) Move Oak Hills E or/and Terralinda to Meadow Park.- That will fill up Meadow Park and Barnes will have friends and if Oak Hills is moved with Terralinda they will be neighbors.The above move will leave space for entire North Summa at Timberland without Portables. And as discussed before both BSD and parents do not want portables for the safety of the kids. As mentioned before Findley is leaving its neighborhood school Stoller and going to new neighborhood CedarMill without any neighborhood friends. Hence an entire North Summa will also give them the opportunity to have more neighborhood friends and at the same time one Summa as mentioned above would be beneficial for both Kids and Teaching and Learning.Just like other schools Findley hopes to have an optimal solution and hence appreciate if BSD would help us with it.

(No change to Highland Park is needed to meet this objective)2. Adjust the attendance boundary for Stoller MS to provide a projected student population of approximately 90% of the permanent capacity of Stoller MS. (No change to Highland Park is needed to meet this objective)3. Review and adjust the attendance boundaries of other middle schools, as needed, to accommodate the new Timberland-area middle school boundary. (No change to Highland Park is needed to meet this objective)4. If warranted, study and recommend minor adjustments to elementary and/or high school attendance boundaries in order to reconcile split feeder patterns or otherwise improve the alignment of attendance boundaries between all school levels. There's a clear misunderstanding as to where Barnes ES kids will be attending High School due to their Dual Language Program. If they enter the DL program, their families make a contractual agreement to attend through 12th grade which would lead them to Beaverton High School. Anyone that opts out of this program at Barnes ES is then assigned to William Walker which feeds to Cedar Park and then BHS. With this in mind, Barnes cannot be considered a clear feeder to SHS. This is why Oak Hills East should attend middle school with Terra Linda and West Oak Hills should attend middle school with Bethany to stay in line with Objective 4 which is to establish clear feeders.2. Barnes Dual Language students are not part of the Sunset feeding community. Barnes will soon be 100% Dual Language and their kids are in separate classes in middle school. It's not that we're snooty, it's that we just don't know them. Their kids are kept completely separate. BSD has created this program and this division, it has nothing to do with the Oak Hills kids not socializing with them. Just like they have done with Summa, the district needs to quantify the number of dual language students and remove their numbers from the Sunset-feeding numbers. 4. As Oak Hills East identifies with the Cedar Mill community, it would be best to attend Timberland for middle school. As Oak Hills West identifies with the Westview community, they should remain at Westview and attend middle school with Bethany. 4. By establishing clean feeders it also supports walkability to our respective high schools. All of Oak Hills East is included in the 2 mile walkability radius of Sunset. Part of Oak Hills West lies within the 2 mile walkability radius of Westview. If Westview truly needs to unload students, please move students from schools that are already being bussed in order to save the precious transportation dollars of BSD. For example, to increase the number of Sunset-feeding kids at Stoller, all of Jacob Wismer should attend Sunset. 5. We have had several Town Hall meetings (some attended by school board members) in our homes, the school, and the community center of Oak Hills. We are united in our message to split before middle school. One dissenting voice with no affected child at a school board meeting does not represent our unified recommendation. 6. Oak Hills does not want to become the "fix-it" school to help FRL numbers at any one school. Everyone knew various details and could expound on them without wondering why or having to search through emails on their laptop or phone. Please establish clear feeders for Oak Hills. The majority of us would prefer to maintain the split, but request this take place before Middle School and not High School. To assume we should know and be friends with Barnes kids at Meadow Park shows lack of understanding on how the Dual Language program works. Oak Hills kids at Meadow Park do not have many opportunities to associate with Barnes kids as many of them are involved in the dual language program and the classes do not intersect. Oak Hills East would prefer to be at Timberland, a clean feeder to SHS. Respectively, Oak Hills West would prefer to attend middle school with other Westview bound students. We are a sunset feeder and thus that JC factor should have us at Timberland. We are the closest thing to a title 1 school north of 26 and will likely be a title 1 once construction is complete on a 92 unit low income housing project in our area. We provide the only socioeconomic balance to Timberland and we belong there based on that JC factor. There is plenty of room for us at Timberland and we meet that JC factor. Terra Linda into Timberland meets all 4 JC factors. We currently have over 6 times as many free and reduced lunch students as Findley, we have over 3 and a half times as many free and reduced lunch students as Bonnie Slope, we have almost 3 times the free and reduced lunch students as Cedar Mill, and we have almost double that of Oak Hills. Terra Linda is the last choice you should make to make a southern school more balanced. The Timberland boundary was voted in 14 to 2, it had stronger support than any other boundary that was decided on. Do not start backtracking now. If you are going to change Timberland to account for poverty in the central Beaverton neighborhoods then you really need to adjust Stoller as well as that is the most concentrated wealth in the district currently. If you pull Terra Linda out of Timberland and create 2 concentrated super elite schools while bussing neighborhood kids that are poor and Hispanic out then you are abandoning every single JC factor. In the last meeting, a committee member had a great suggestion to make Meadow Park a hub for Summa. I think that numbers will work out. Here are the specifics:(1) Approve ammendment #2 as found on March 12th memorandum. but with changes below. (a) Send the 83 Aloha High school feeding kids of Elmonica and McKinley to Five Oaks. This will reduce Meadow Park FRL. Five Oaks FRL will not be over 50% due to Rock Creek, Bethany, and West Oak Hills. This adds unused spots at Meadow Park to a total of 210.
