



## Community Expectations for Successful Distance Learning

### Parent Expectations

- Provide an environment conducive to learning.
- Ensure that your daughter carefully reads the daily and weekly expectations for each class.
- As appropriate, observe and remain updated on student communication with teachers.

### Student Expectations

- During direct instruction days, students will be expected to login through MyLaReina at the beginning of each period.
- Students will check teacher communications daily to keep track of learning activities, assignments and assessments.
- Students will dedicate appropriate time to learning, comparable to a school day and/or as guided by your teacher(s).
- Students will identify a comfortable and quiet space to study/learn.
- Students will complete all assignments and assessments.
- Assignments will be submitted online.
- Should students have questions, they should contact their teacher directly via email.
- Students will abide by the normal academic expectations and policies.

### Teacher Expectations

- Teachers will communicate with parents and students as needed.
- Teachers will post all assignments and specific course material prior to class.
- Teachers will provide timely feedback.
- Teachers will monitor email.
- Printing an assignment will not be a requirement as students will electronically submit their work.
- Student assignments may include a variety of online and offline activities such as reading in textbooks or other literature, collaborating with friends and family, writing in a journal or notebook, taking pictures or videos.
