## **TPSD Announces Food Delivery Bus Plans**

**TUPELO, Miss.** — In an effort to ensure all area children are fed both a lunch and breakfast, the Tupelo Public School District and the Tupelo/Lee County Hunger Coalition have partnered to create a plan for buses to drop meals at certain stops throughout the city.

While also providing grab-and-go meals at Lawndale and Pierce Street schools, five buses will drop off meals at eight different locations.

Stops and times feature:

Bus 1: 10:45 a.m., Hilldale Apartments; 11:30 a.m., Parkway Terrace

Bus 2: 11 a.m., Oak Creek Apartments, 11:20 a.m.; Tupelo Housing Authority on North Green St.

Bus 3: 11:15 a.m., The Pines at Barnes Crossing and Trace Ridge

Bus 4: 11:40 a.m., Haven Acres

Bus 5: 11:40 a.m., Tupelo Housing Authority on Canal St.; Noon, Feemster Lake Road Apartments
