ENROLLMENT HISTORY

TWENTY YEARS AFTER ITS FOUNDING, ST. MARK'S EPISCOPAL CHURCH EXPANDED ITS MINISTRY TO INCLUDE A DAY SCHOOL. ST. MARK'S EPISCOPAL SCHOOL WAS LAUNCHED IN 1960 WITH A DOZEN CHILDREN IN KINDERGARTEN, EXPANDING TO 1ST GRADE IN 1961 AND 2ND GRADE IN 1964. IN 1971, THE VESTRY VOTED TO ADD 3RD GRADE AND IN 1973 THE SCHOOL EXPANDED AGAIN TO INCLUDE 4TH THROUGH 6TH GRADE. A

7TH GRADE WAS ADDED IN THE FALL OF 1986, AND SIX CHILDREN COMPRISED THE FIRST 8TH GRADE GRADUATING CLASS IN THE SPRING OF 1988. OUR PRESCHOOL 2S, PRESCHOOL 3S, AND KINDERGARTEN CLASSES WERE ADDED IN THE EARLY 1990S, CREATING THE BELOVED PRESCHOOL 2S THROUGH 8TH GRADE SCHOOL WE ENJOY TODAY.
