



Grades PK-5 eLearning Guide – MUSIC – Week 3

PreK and Kindergarten: Steady Beat and Loud vs. Quiet

- The students will sing and move to music.
- The students will move to the beat of the music.
- The students will identify and perform loud and quiet.

First Grade: High/Low Sounds and Rhythm Patterns

- The students will perform and identify high and low sounds.
- The students will read and perform rhythm patterns using quarter and eighth notes.

Second Grade: Mi, Sol, La and Rhythm Patterns

- The students will sing and move to music.
- The students will read mi, so, and la (m sl).
- The students will read, create, and perform rhythm patterns.

Third Grade: $\frac{3}{4}$ Meter, High Do, Listening and Responding

- The students will read, create and perform a rhythm in $\frac{3}{4}$ meter.
- The students will read and perform music that uses high do.
- The students will write a response to the music of Strauss using musical terminology.
- The students will tell what Strauss was famous for.

Fourth Grade: Pentatonic Scale, Ostinato, Listening and Responding

- The students will identify the notes in the pentatonic scale: do, re, mi, sol, and la (drm sl).
- The students will create and perform an ostinato.
- The students will describe music by a Baroque composer.

Fifth Grade: Tempo and Rondo Form

- The students will define and perform a variety of tempos.
