



# GOOGLE CLASSROOM

## A Quick Guide for Parents

### INTRODUCTION

Google Classroom is a platform that allows teachers to distribute assignments, make announcements, and moderate discussions with students.

Students join with a code or are added by the teachers. Guardians can be invited to have email notifications sent to them when assignments are created or missing.

### EMAIL SUMMARIES

Missing work—Work that's late at the time the email was sent

Upcoming work—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or work that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails)

Class activity—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers

**Guardians can't access Classroom or their child's assignments due to privacy laws. Guardians can only get email summaries, if your child's teacher allows it.**


### Facts about Google Classroom

Guardians who are set up with guardian access will not have access to the classroom stream (discussion and posts) and will not have access to assignments turned in by other students.

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As a guardian, you must receive and accept an email invitation before you can receive email summaries. Only teachers and administrators from your student's school can send these invitations. You have 120 days to accept an invitation before it expires.
