To recognize a student's commitment and leadership skills, our academy has established an AFJROTC scholarship for students desiring to participate in the Florida Prep AFJROTC Program. Students in grades 8 through 11 will be able to benefit from this scholarship. The purpose of this scholarship is to assist these young men and women in their pursuit of academic success, character development and to prepare them to become strong leaders.

Eligible students may apply for the scholarship by completing this application and submitting it to the Admissions Department along with the student application. There will be qpg AFJROTC scholarship given per year for new students.

In order to be considered for the AFJROTC Scholarship, ALL of the items on the Application Checklist must be completed and received by the Florida Prep Admissions Office0

Eligibility:

- An applicant must be currently enrolled in an accredited public or private grade school, or be a state-approved home school student.
- An applicant must have a 3.0 grade point average or higher in order to be considered.
- Student must maintain a 3.0 grade point average or higher to qualify for this annual scholarship.
- Independent of this scholarship application, applicants must have applied to and been accepted to Florida Prep.

- 2.) Why would you like to enroll in the JROTC Program?

Scholarship finalists will be invited to interview with the selection committee.
