Recommended

Your child may need some help from you.

You can limit the time to just 10-15 minutes of quick practice.

- Letter and sound flash cards
- Sight word flash cards
- Number flash cards
- Reading books together

Independent

Your child should be able to do on their own.

- Epic- iPad books to read
- Zearn- iPad math activities
- Teach My Monster- iPad reading activities
- Todo Math- iPad math activities
- Tumblebooks- iPad books to read
- Draw and write (shopping list, notes/ cards to family or neighbors, a story,
- Build (legos, blocks, cards etc.)
- Look at books

How to build your child's independent time stamina: Set a timer for 6-7 minutes and say, "We're going to have quiet work/ reading time now. You will get to work quietly on your own until the timer rings." Praise them for working until the timer. Increase the time by a minute daily.
