An "event" is an occurrence that involves more than just a regularly scheduled practice, meeting or extracurricular activity

• ACTION ITEM: Discussion and possible action to allow the sale to students of beverages not listed in Section 10-221q of the Connecticut General Statutes provided that the following conditions are met: 1) the sale is in connection with an event occurring after the end of the regular school day or on the weekend; 2) the sale is at the location of the event; and 3) the beverages are not sold from a vending machine or school store
