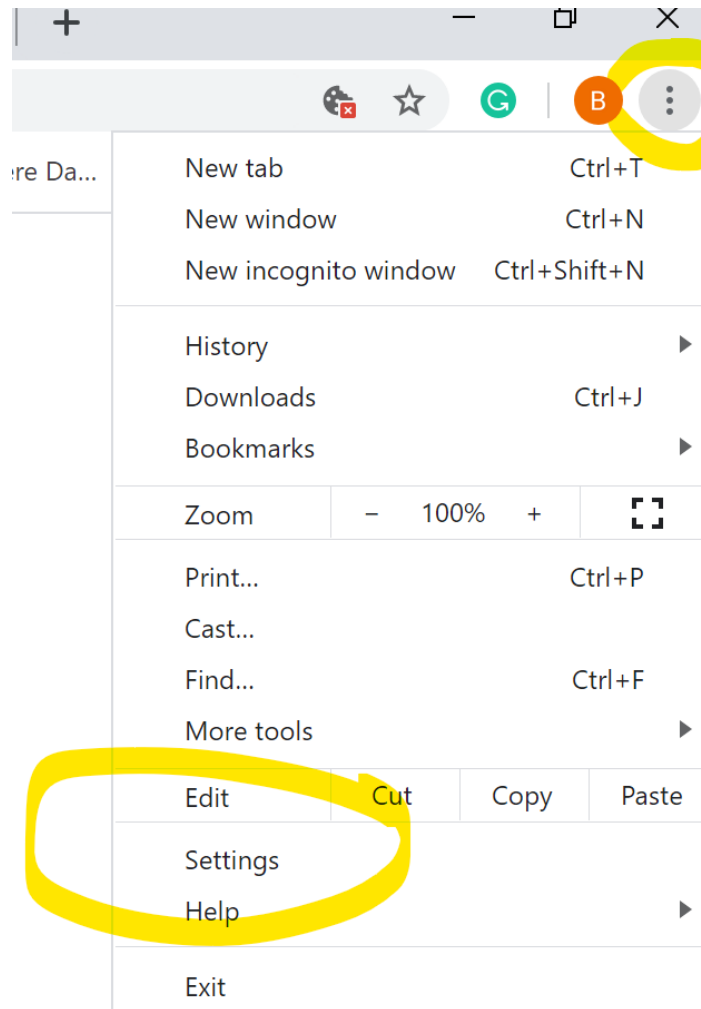


In Chrome, go to the menu icon and click on settings.

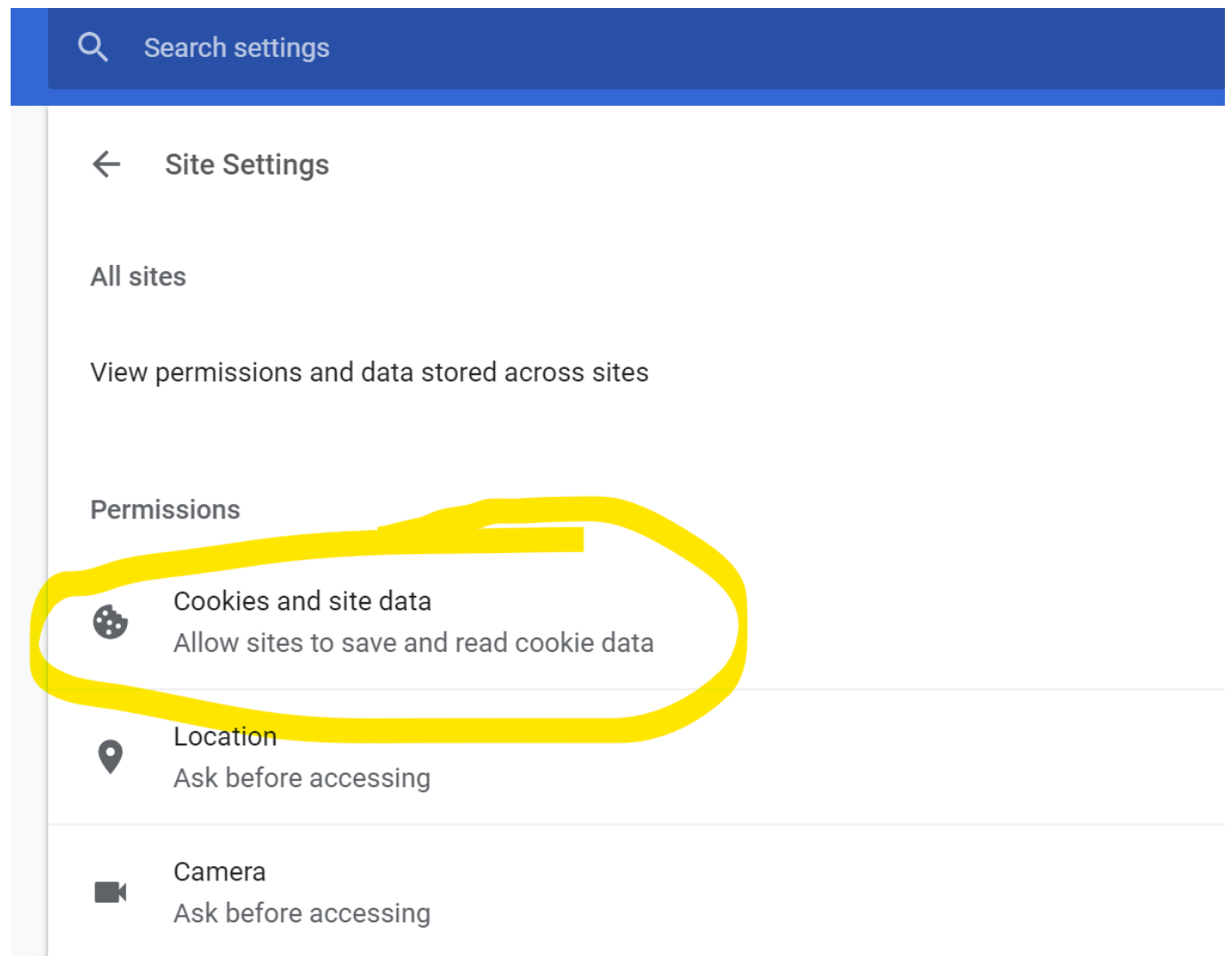
