Content Area	Assignment

Writing:	30 minutes daily. From the April writing calendar pick 1 prompt daily to write about. It can be written on any paper or typed in a word document. The writing pieces need to be turned in. Practice writing with correct capitals, spacing, and punctuation.
Vocabulary/Language Development:	30 minutes daily. Practice the new vocabulary words. Use the vocabulary words in sentences, sharing them orally or writing them down.
PE:	30 minutes daily. Get up and move. Do jumping jacks, simon says, dance to go noodle or you tube songs, or any other activity that gets you moving.

Weekly vocabulary:

Distracts

Define: If something distracts you, it takes you attention away from what you were focused on.

Example: The sound of his brother playing can distract Jon from his homework.

Ask: What can distract you when you are working?

Squeaky

Define: A squeaky sound is a high pitched sound.

Example: The rusty gate made a squeaky sound when it opened.

Ask: Would you want to hear squeaky sound when you were trying to sleep? Why or why not?

Scrambled

Define: Scrambled means "climbed" or "walked" quickly.

Example: The people scrambled to get in line.

Ask: Why might you scramble to get in line? Explain.

Suddenly

Define: If something happens suddenly, it happens quickly, without notice.

Example: The sky suddenly got dark.

Ask: Name a word that is the opposite of suddenly.

Senses


Define: The senses give us information about the world around us.


Example: The five senses are seeing, hearing, feeling, tasting, and smelling.


