- Five-Day Threes: Monday through Friday, until noon, 3:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m.

FOURS AND PRE-KINDERGARTEN:

Children must be 4 years old by September 1. Classes begin at 8:00 a.m.

• 5 days a week until noon, 3:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m.

FREE DROP-OFF:

Free, daily Early-Bird drop-off at 7:30 a.m. for Threes through Pre-Kindergarten. For Five-Day Twos, Threes, Fours and Pre-Kindergarten, afternoon care is also available on a drop-in basis.
