



With a goal of healthy children in our schools, the school code includes health requirements for Illinois students. The health requirements are listed below:

1. A **physical examination** (State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination) conducted within one year **prior** to student entering **pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, sixth grade**, or transferring into Illinois from outside of the State or outside of the country. The exam must include **screening for lead** exposure on students less than seven years old and **diabetic screening**. (**Students participating in interscholastic sports must have a physical exam on file conducted within the last 395 days.**)
2. A **dental examination** for students entering **kindergarten, second** and **sixth grade**.
3. An **eye examination** for students entering **kindergarten** and **students transferring into Illinois** schools.
4. Proof of **required immunizations** (see IDPH chart).

We rely on your support and cooperation. Please have your child's exams and immunizations to school by **August 1st**. By Illinois law, students who do not meet the health requirements will be excluded from school. If you need further information, please contact your school's health services office.
