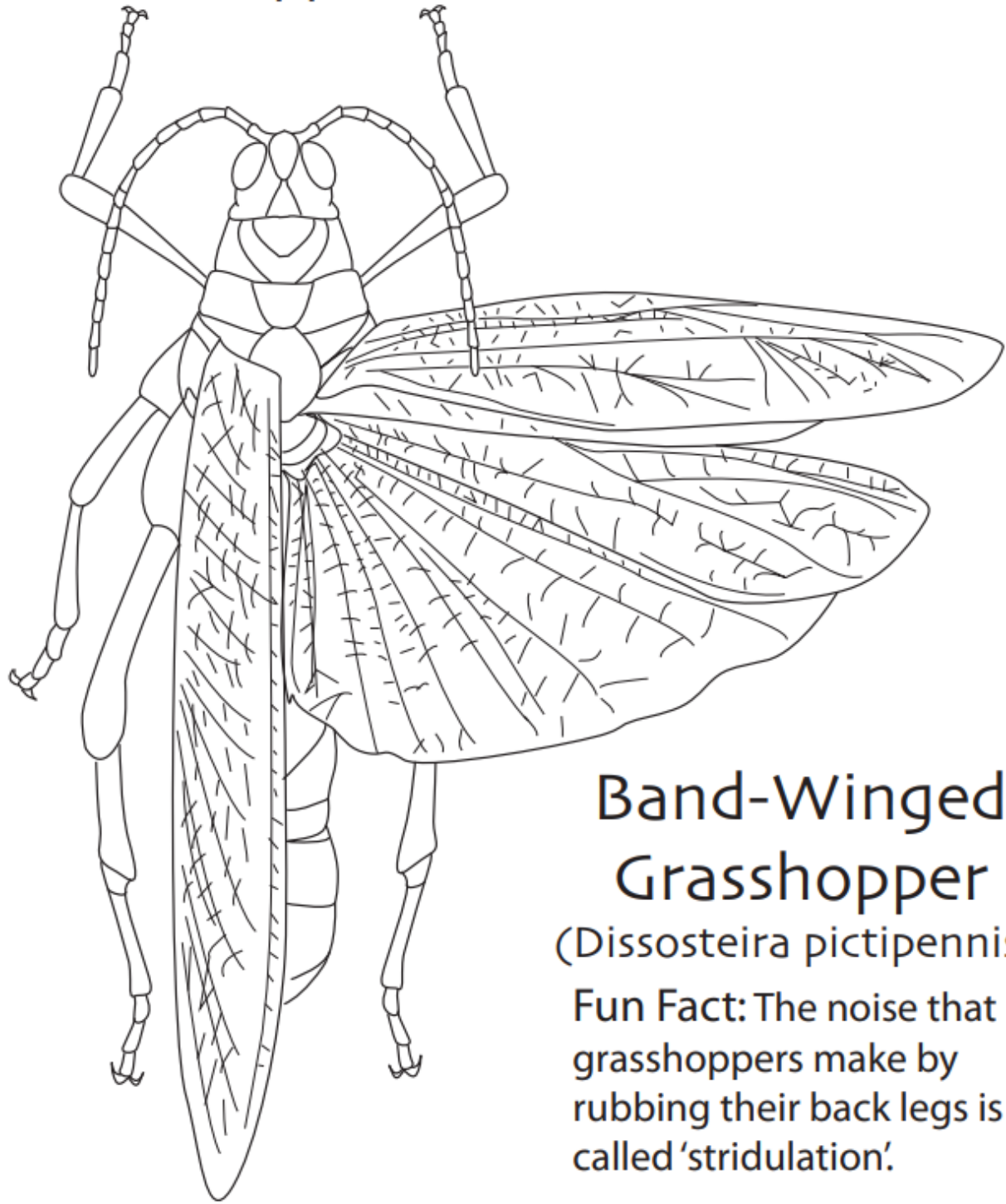

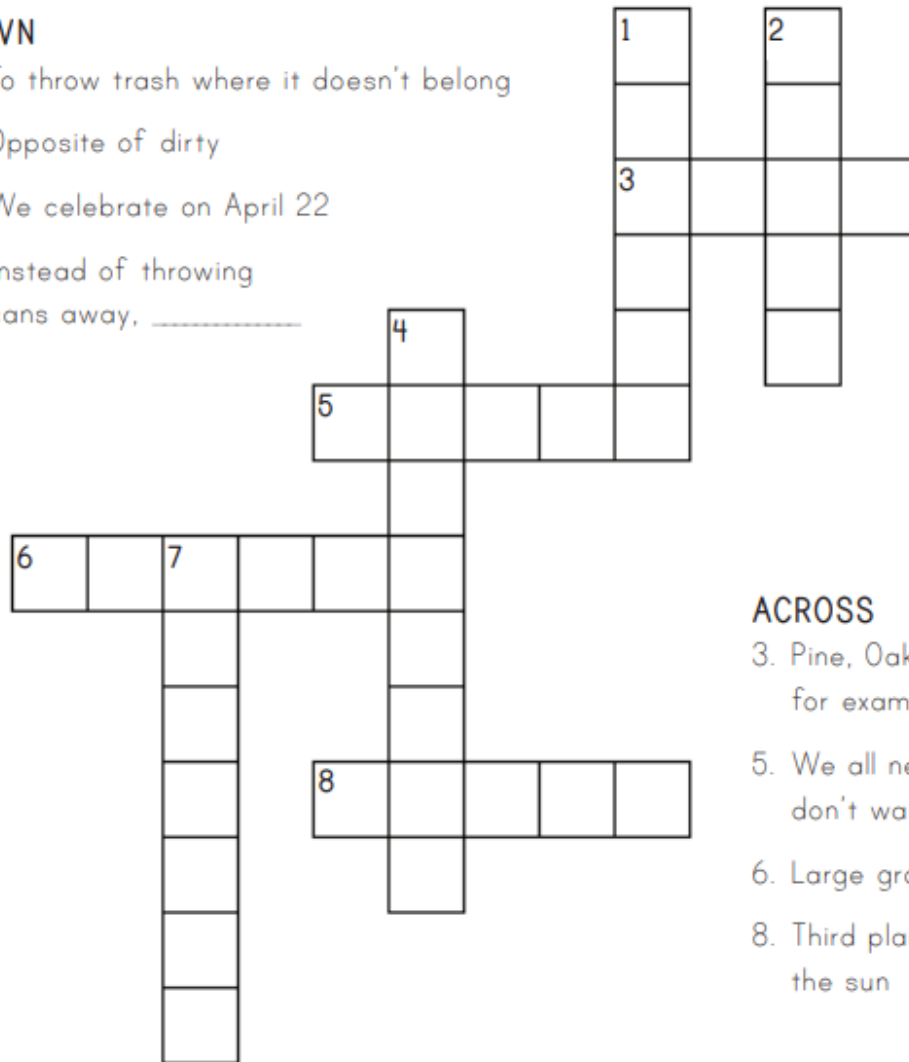
Earth Day Crossword

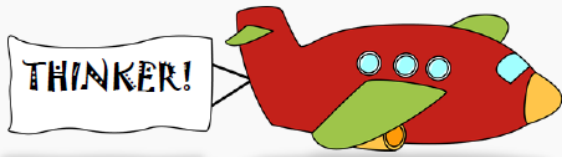

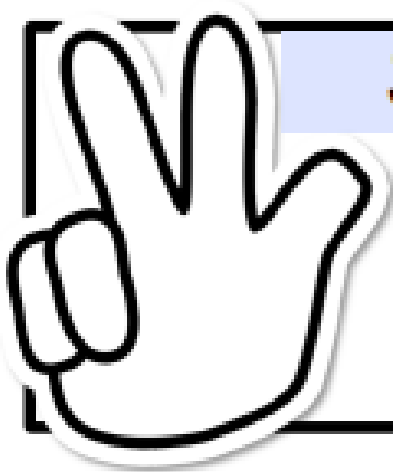
