To play: -Turn over a cardChild says the number and does that amount of the correct exercise. Example: 6 of hearts. Thursday	Parent initial to verify reading	Prompt: Talk about how you would dress differently in all 4 seasons. Why?  Parent initial to verify	Activity: Numbers & more/less.  Get blank paper and write a number on each sheet. Focus on numbers 10-20. Roll each paper into a ball and prepare to have a snowball fight!  When you say "freeze" after 15 seconds of throwing, the players open their paper and read the number. Parent can ask child, "What would the number be if we add 1 more? 1 less?" Example, the paper says 8. So, child would say 7 for one less.
