PURPOSE

Under the direction and supervision of the Middle School (MS) Music Teacher, the Accompanist in Music/Choir is primarily responsible in providing music accompaniment (piano) for the choir classes, recitals, after school clubs and other special events. The Accompanist independently performs duties which require advance sight-reading and technical skills and wide range of related tasks. The Accompanist will also teach break out sections during choir classes and support the tuning and setting up of the MS Strings and MS Band students as directed. The Accompanist is evaluated by the MS music teachers and MS Principal.

- 13. Performing other related duties and assuming other responsibilities as assigned by the MS Music Teacher, including and not limited to other projects when deemed necessary
