


Born in Boston and deeply influenced by its expressionist tradition of figurative painting (Hyman Bloom, Max Beckmann, David Aronson, Karl Zerbe, et al.), Roth studied at the School of the Museum of Fine Arts (Boston), Tufts University, and the Skowhegan School of Painting & Sculpture. Later influences were figurative artists such as Edgar Degas, Raphael Soyer, Alice Neel, and Horst Janssen. She arrived on the Chicago art scene committed to synthesizing these two

artistic worlds. While teaching figure drawing throughout the Chicago area, community activism and the Chicago Women's Caucus for Art presidency in 2001 led her to found the still vital Ravenswood ArtWalk. Her drawings and paintings are in corporate, museum, and private collections across the country.
