This document shows the fees payable by all students for the 2020 academic year. Fees are reviewed annually and are subject to change. Fees increase by 3.25% in 2020. We expect annual increase going forward to be in the region of 3% to 5%. All fees are quoted in Singapore dollars and include 7% GST. GST is subject to change.

For students starting the IB Diploma Programme in January 2020, fees for Grade 11 and 12 are payable as follows: 1st Term (T₁) of Grade 11 = \$21529 followed by three further payments (T_{2,3&4}) of \$15529 in the rest of Grade 11 and 12.
- ** This is the **tuition fee** of the IB Diploma Course for a student in Grade 12 in 2020. Grade 12 students have already paid a front-loaded fee for Grade 11 in 2019.

- (1) Application fee is non-refundable. This is payable when the application is submitted.
- (2) Registration fee is payable on acceptance of a place at SJI International. Registration fee is non-refundable. The registration fee includes a \$50 locker fee.
- (3) There are two terms each academic year.
- (4) The security deposit will be automatically refunded to the students upon their graduation from SJI International, at the end of Grade 12. In the event of early withdrawal for students in Grade 7 to 10, notice must be given in writing to the Principal by 28 February (if leaving in the term that ends in May/June of the same year) or by 30 of September (if leaving in the term that ends in November/December of the same year). **Failure to provide adequate notice will result in SJI International retaining the Security Deposit.** The Security Deposit for any student starting Grade 11 or 12 will only be refunded upon completion of the full two year IB Programme. **SJI International will retain the Security Deposit for any Grade 11 or 12 students who leave the course before completing the full two year programme.**
- (5) Compulsory Trip Fees are approximate, based on 2019 costs, and are subject to change. There are no compulsory trips for G10 and G12, unless signed up for the NYAA Award. Parents will receive notification about these trips at the appropriate time in the year, including the final confirmed fee.
- (6) There are additional compulsory trips for students taking particular subjects or NYAA Silver or Gold. The costs of additional trips are approximate, based on 2019 costs, and are subject to change. The following are the approximate cost of these trips: G9 IGCSE Geography = \$1203.00; G11 IB Geography = \$1230.00; and G11 IB Biology and ESS = \$1071.00; NYAA Silver = \$1280 to \$1400; NYAA Gold = \$1231 to \$1480). Parents will receive notification about these trips at the appropriate time in the year, including the final confirmed fee.
- (7) Examination Fees subject to change by Examination Boards. These are billed prior to the G10 and G12 examinations.
- (8) Art Material Fee (payable at start of each academic year) will be included in the 2nd Term Fees invoice.
- (9) Year Book Fee will be included in the 2nd Term Fees invoice.
- (10) ISOS Travel Risk Insurance and Enhance Student Accident Insurance (payable at start of each academic year) will be included in the 1st Term Fees invoice.

Payment Details

Payment Procedure (for families living in Singapore)

All fees must be paid either by **Cheque, Red Dot** or **Electronic Transfer**.

Payment Procedure (for families of international students living outside Singapore)

All fees must be paid either by **Cheque (Singapore bank account only), Cashier's Order, Red Dot** or **Electronic Transfer**.

By Cashier's Order (Bank Draft)

All Cashier's Orders must be made payable to "SJI International".

By Cheque

- The school only accepts cheques from **Singaporean bank accounts**.
- All cheques must be crossed and made payable to "SJI International".
- Please note the names of the child on the back of all cheques. Please also write "NEW" for first-time payments for a new student and include a contact name and telephone number.
