

## First Grade Digital Plan

April 13, 2020

Dear Parents,

We have assigned digital curriculum in four areas: Reading, Writing, Math and Science.

You will need to go to 1) Adelaide's Home Page 2) Parents and Students 3) Student Resources.

You can then access Waterford, McGraw-Hill/ConnectEd, ST Math, Imagine Math (Imagine Learning), and Pearson EasyBridge. When you are prompted to enter the email, you will need to enter your child's full email that ends with @go.dsdmail.net.

For Science, go to MysteryDoug.com. Choose one first grade video each day. The activities are optional.

Please work on the following programs daily for 20 minutes each:

1) ST Math, **Your child must back arrow at the end of ST Math until they get to the bubble report or their work will not be saved.** If your child has finished ST Math, they can do Imagine Math Facts instead.

2) Pearson EasyBridge and then Imagine Math (20 minutes for both combined) We are aware that many of the activities will not open in EasyBridge Math. We have simplified it for this week. We have only loaded the tutorial videos and the worksheets. Let's see how that works. Hopefully there will be less frustration. Some of your children are not actually doing the worksheets. Make sure they click on the yellow pencil on the right and fill out the worksheet. We can see their answers.

3) ConnectEd/McGraw-Hill

4) Waterford. Please work on Waterford until your child comes to a STOP sign (approximately 20-25 minutes). If your child has finished Waterford, they can start doing Imagine Literacy instead

We will be able to monitor your child's progress.

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### Instructions to get into EasyBridge Math

1. Go into Clever (The same path as for Waterford and ST Math)
2. Click on Pearson EasyBridge.
3. Click on the bottom line: Investigations 3 Common Core Grade 1
4. Click on the middle circle labeled Classes
5. Work on the tutorials and pages that are assigned for today's date.
6. If eText & Tools is showing - push hide to make the page easier to navigate.
