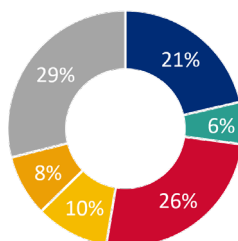
FACILITIES: Library Media Center with over 40,000 print items, computers in all classrooms and wireless internet access throughout the campus, 1 computer per student in grades 1 through 5 in the classroom environment, one laptop checked out to each student in grades 6 through 12, fully equipped science laboratory classrooms, purpose-built art and music classrooms, state-of-the-art 450-seat theater, full-service cafeteria and snack bar, 1,400m² covered gymnasium, more than 10,000m² of exterior sports fields for basketball, soccer and other sports.

ENGLISH: English is the language of instruction. English support (*Foundations of English*) is provided based on individual student needs for no additional fee.

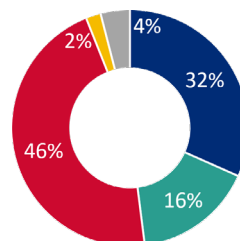
OTHER LANGUAGES: Portuguese Native Language and Foundations of Portuguese are offered for all grade levels plus French, Spanish and Chinese starting in Grade 7.

STUDENTS: Total of 724 at the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year representing 57 nationalities. Among these there are 155 American, 42 from English-speaking countries such as the U.K., Canada, and South Africa, and 185 Portuguese. **33% of our students have more than one nationality.**

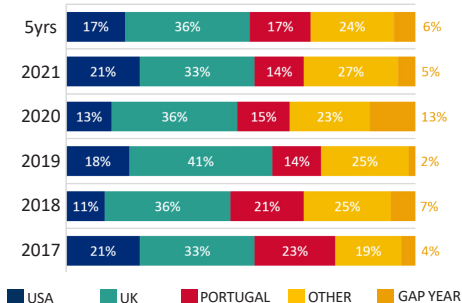
FACULTY



FACULTY: In the 2021-2022 school year, there are 98 full-time faculty members, including 31 U.S. citizens, 16 from other English speaking countries such as the U.K., Canada and Ireland, and 45 host-country nationals. The remaining are from other nationalities including Bulgaria, Brazil and France. **69% of the core teachers are native English-speakers.**

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS: In 2021 there were 58 graduating seniors: 12 students matriculated into American Universities, 19 into British Universities, 8 into Portuguese Universities, and 16 into universities elsewhere in the world. 3 students took a gap year.

CAISL is most fortunate to start another school year with all grades on campus for full in-person classes. Provision for distance learning is made for those students who need to be absent for health or other valid reasons. Virus mitigation strategies were implemented throughout campus and are kept at all times including:

- Air monitoring system and automatic ventilation to maintain the air quality even with cooling/heating system on.
- Masks for Grades 3 and older, handwashing and sanitizing of spaces, distancing in class and out, ventilation throughout the buildings.
- Cohorts ("bubbles") of students who remain together throughout the day.
- Each bubble has its own space—the students stay in the class and the teachers move between bubbles.
- Each bubble has its own area for lunch (in the cafeteria or in the classroom) and for recess/breaks.
- Continuation of many activities and events (Student Councils, Modern United Nations, Fine Arts Showcases, Community Service) but in a virtual environment.
