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### Easement & Right of Way

The Board of Education of the Olentangy Local School District, "Grantor(s)", in consideration of \$1.00, the easement terms, and other good and valuable consideration from Ohio Power Company an Ohio corporation and a unit of American Electric Power, 850 Tech Center Drive, Gahanna, OH 43230-6605, "Grantee", the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, grants and conveys with general warranty covenants to Grantee its successors, assigns, lessees, and licensees, a right of way and easement, "Easement" for electric and other current/future energy or communication purposes, overhead and underground, in, on, over, through and across the following described lands situated in Village of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio, and being in Farm Lot 23 and Farm Lot 24, Quarter Township No(s) 4 Township No(s) 3 North, Range No(s) 19 West. Being part of a 17.199 acre tract of land as described in Official Records Volume 0020 Page 363 of the Delaware County Recorder's Office (Parcel # 319-434-02-003-001).

Said lines and facilities shall be constructed within a certain strip of land fifteen (15) feet in width, situated West from, adjacent to and continuous with the West road right of way line of Liberty Road, as now or hereafter laid out.

This Easement conveys all necessary and convenient rights for the Easement's use, including, without limitation, the rights to: construct, operate, maintain, inspect, protect, repair, replace, enlarge, upgrade, extend and remove utility facilities within the Easement, all necessary and convenient facilities which include but are not limited to: poles, anchors, guys, supporting structures, conductors, conduits, enclosures, grounding systems, foundations, manholes, transformers, and associated equipment, adding thereto from time to time; perform grading or filling for such facilities; cut, trim, remove and/or otherwise control, with herbicides or by other means, at Grantee's option (without any liability to Grantor), any trees, limbs or branches, brush, shrubs, undergrowth, of whatever size, buildings, structures, or other obstructions that in Grantee's reasonable judgment endanger or interfere with the safety or use of its facilities, both within and adjoining the Easement. Within the Easement, Grantor shall not: place any structures, piles or debris, interfere with lateral support, change the level of the ground by excavation or mounding without Grantee's written consent, allow any construction that would be inconsistent with the National Electric Safety Code or Grantee's design standards, and, for underground lines, permit or cause any excavation, except for other utilities, provided such utilities rights do not conflict with this Easement. This Easement also conveys the right of ingress and egress in and over any reasonable routes at all times.

If any governmental authority requires Grantee to relocate the facilities contemplated by this grant, this Easement conveys the right to relocate such facilities to a comparable location determined by mutual agreement, without the need for a new easement.

Grantor may use its property for all purposes not inconsistent with the full enjoyment of the Easement, but Grantor acknowledges high voltage electric lines will be constructed within the Easement and Grantor shall use its property in a manner consistent with all applicable safety rules and regulations for working near electric lines. Safety/required clearance issues may be referred to Grantee's Engineering Group. Grantee shall restore the premises or pay reasonable damages done to fences, drains, seeded lawns, gates, ditches and crops caused by Grantee's use of the Easement. Grantor has authority to grant this Easement. No delay or omission by Grantee in exercising any right hereunder shall operate as a waiver or forfeiture of such right. This Easement grant is effective and binding upon the parties, their successors, assigns, lessees, licensees, heirs and legal representatives, and if any term hereunder is held invalid, the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

Grantor has determined that the easement area is not presently needed for school purposes and cannot be advantageously disposed by sale. The property conveyed herein is being acquired by Grantee for the purposes set forth in this easement and shall not be used for any other purpose.

Grantee shall construct and maintain any improvements within the easement area at its sole cost and expense and it shall use all commercially reasonable efforts to minimize interference with the use and occupancy of the property by Grantor during Grantee's work in the easement area. Grantee shall replace and restore any area on Grantor's property disturbed by Grantee to as near as practical to its original condition.

Nothing contained in this Agreement is intended, nor shall it be construed as, a dedication of the easement area, or any part thereof, to public use or to grant or create any rights in, to or for the benefit of the general public or any owner or occupant of any property adjoining or near the Grantor's property.







## ADDENDUM

American Electric Power Company/Ohio Power Company agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Grantor(s) against and from any and all liability, cost and expense arising from injury or damage to other persons, or their property, or the property of the Grantor(s), caused by the negligence of American Electric Power/ Ohio Power Company in the use and occupancy of the premises subject to the rights of way and easements hereby granted or in the use and occupancy of said right of way and easement granted to American Electric Power/Ohio Power, in the construction, maintenance and operation of its structures located in, on, across, under or over the property of the Grantor(s) or immediately adjacent thereto, unless such loss and/or damage is caused by the negligence of the Grantor(s). Nothing in this Agreement shall be interpreted to increase Grantor's tort liability under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 2744.

The Ohio Department of Transportation has requested American Electric Power / Ohio Power Company to relocate the overhead electric facilities along Liberty Road and Jewett Road for their roundabout project at the intersection of Liberty Road and Jewett Road. The electric facilities affected are on the West side of Liberty Road and extend from Tyler Run Elementary School to the Southwest corner of Torrington Drive and Liberty Road, also from the corner of Liberty Road and Jewett Road heading East on the South side of Jewett ending just before the train tracks. The Ohio Department of Transportation has requested American Electric Power to have the conversion completed by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.

American Electric Power requires an easement signed and notarized by the property owner in order to relocate the facilities. Please review the attached easement and contact me.

The easement will be recorded at the Delaware County Recorder's Office so the original executed document is required in our office for recording purposes.
