CHANGES:

- 1) Attachment G, is hereby replaced with the Attachment G that is a part of this Addendum.
- 2) The Sample Contract and Sample PWA Attached to the Solicitation may be changed, as applicable, to remove prevailing wage requirements, to add provisions to make them applicable for only some types or work, or to add provisions of similar effect.

CLARIFICATIONS:

Question: We have a question whether Oregon Prevailing Wage Rate (Davis-Bacon) laws will apply to this contract? It would seem that they would not, since the total yearly amount (at least for now) is substantially less than the \$50,000 threshold. Please verify if this will be the case, as this will affect backflow repair rates.

Answer: The District does not expect Davis-Bacon wages to be applicable to Work under this Solicitation. The \$50,000 threshold is just one of multiple factors to consider in determining when the State of Oregon's Prevailing Wage Rates (PWR) will apply. The District will evaluate the entire contract, as well as individual PWA's executed thereunder to determine the applicability of Oregon's PWRs apply. As such, please see the changes to the Solicitation listed above.
