

Novi Community Schools - 2020 Summer School Program

Questions & Answers

Who can Attend Summer School?

- A student who has failed a required course and needs to make that up
- A student who is interested in taking classes for credit advancement
- A student who wants to open up their schedule for the following year
- A student in good academic standing in the 8th- 11th grade with counselor and parent approval

How many credits can I earn?

- Students can earn one (1) credit (session 1 & 2) upon successful completion of course, final exam and required attendance. Credit will be determined by home school for out-of-district students.

What is the Summer School Schedule?

- Session I - June 29, 2020-July 13, 2020 (Final Exam July 13, 2020)
- Session II - July 14, 2020- July 28, 2020 (Final Exam July 28, 2020)

What time does the class begin and end?

- Classes begin at 8:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m.

What is the Tuition?

- Novi High School Student \$295 per class (.5 credit)
- Out-of-district Students \$320 per class (.5 credit)

What is the Attendance/Credit/Audit Policy?

- Students are **REQUIRED** to attend the entire 22-day session. **No exceptions.**
- Students whose vacation and/or camp schedule interfere with the summer school schedule should not enroll.
- Attendance violation will result in being dropped from the class, no refund, and loss of credit.
- Semester B** classes can **ONLY** be audited for the 2020 Summer School Program.

What is the Code of Conduct?

- The Novi Community Schools code of Conduct will be followed by all summer school students.
- Summer School is a closed campus program.
- No visitors are permitted on school property except for district employees.
- Students will not be permitted to stay in their cars during school hours and smoking is not permitted on school property.

What about Lunch?

- Students may bring lunch to school. Snacks and beverages are available for purchase.

When is Registration?

- Courses will be available for registration Online at www.novi.k12.mi.us/communityed/summer-school
- All students will be required to complete a 2020 Summer High School Credit Verification form **online during the registration process.**

What about Refunds?

- All dropped courses must be completed on or before the 5th day of class at a pro-rated rate: Drops on the 6th day will result in **NO REFUND**, and an “E” grade will be issued. There will be a **5%** processing fee on all refunds.
