Ohio English Language Proficiency Assessment Results and Exiting Criteria

Students who are qualified in the English Language Learning (ELL) program took their state language proficiency assessments in February and March. There are four parts to the test: Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing. We will receive the results from the Ohio Department of Education in May and a family report will be mailed to your home in June. The results of this test are used to determine your child's ELL services for the 2019-2020 school year. Students who score "Proficient" on this assessment are exited from the ELL Program and monitored for 2 years. Monitoring includes communication and collaboration with classroom and content area teachers to ensure students that have exited are maintaining grade level expectations. If you have any questions about this assessment, please contact your child's ELL Teacher.

Elementary Families:

Elementary ELL teachers will send home a Student Goals Report for English language acquisition. This progress report describes how your child is progressing with English language skills at a particular level. The goals were created based on assessment data and information from a standardized screener or state language proficiency test. The current progress levels are based on skills we have observed in the classroom and/or skills in small group instruction. We communicate progress toward goals for Quarter 2 (January) and Quarter 4 (May).
