To Novi Community School District Parents and Community Members:

I know many of you have had questions arising from the closure of our schools necessitated by Governor Whitmer's Executive Order. We have created a "[Frequently Asked Questions](#)" page. We have an update on our high school summer school program. We believe that we will have the ability to run summer school, at Novi High School, as we have in the past. The summer school program will start one week later this year in light of the pandemic. The new dates are as follows:

June 29, 2020 - July 28, 2020 at Novi High School (see website for details).

This year, in an effort to help support our Novi Community and Students, we will be offering an online ELECTIVE class summer program via Michigan Virtual. Students can take up to 1 credit in the *online program*, which is June 8 - August 14th.

Also, in a continued effort to support our Novi students, we will offer for this summer ONLY the option for students to audit the course they were enrolled in during the 2019-20 school year (semester class B class) at the time of registration.

Information will be posted on the website this week. Registration will be through the Community Ed Office and the cost is \$355 per half credit (in district) and \$370 out of district.
