- ❖ Some Activities/Group information

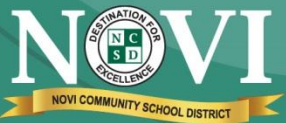
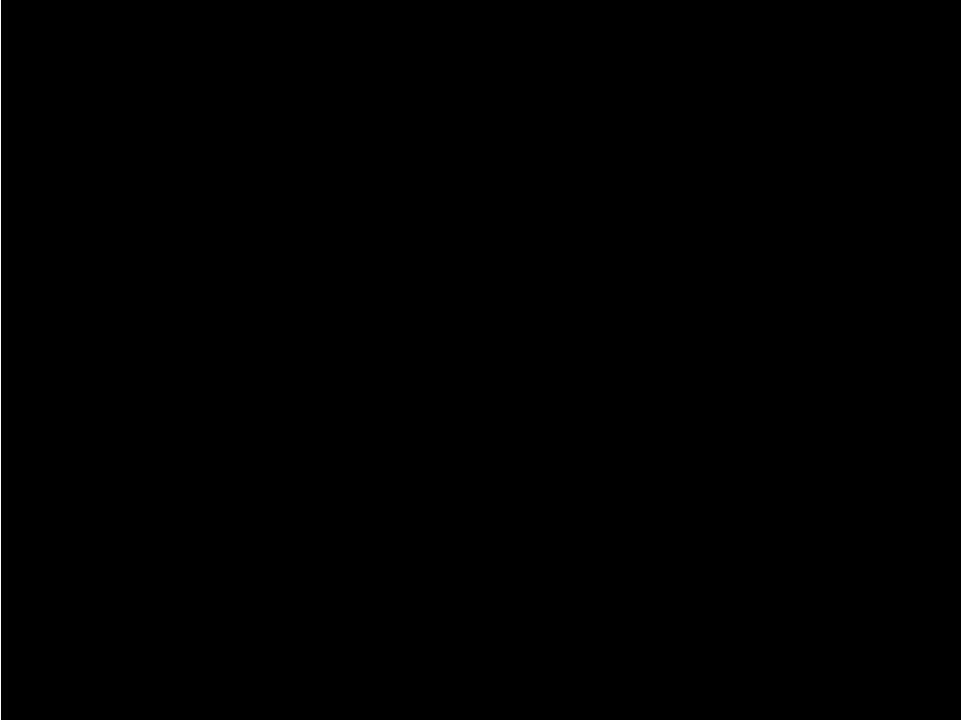
Parents can also set notifications by text and/or email for up-to-date summary reports and teacher messages.

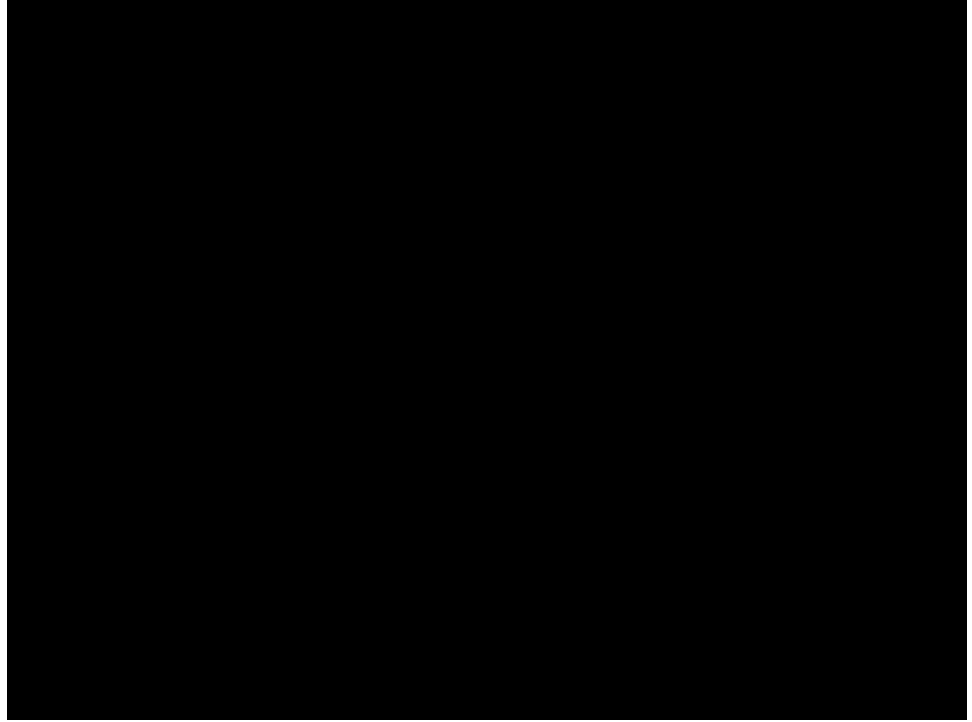
