Bus Conduct

Bus transportation is a privilege extended only to students who display safe conduct while preparing to ride, riding or leaving the bus while traveling to/from a Lompoc Unified School or Lompoc Unified School District sponsored activity. Continued disorderly conduct or persistent refusal to submit to the direction of the driver shall be sufficient reason for a student to be denied transportation.

The Superintendent or designee shall establish regulations related to bus conduct, bus driver authority, and the suspension of riding privileges. The Governing Board shall make these rules available to parents/guardians and students. (5 CCR 14103)

Bus Surveillance Systems

Video cameras with microphones may be used on school buses to monitor student behavior while traveling to and from school and school activities. The Board believes that audio and video monitoring deters misconduct and ensures student and staff safety. Students found to be in violation of the district's bus conduct rules shall be subject to discipline in accordance with district policy and regulations.
