# **BSD Graduation Pathways 2020**

This guidance applies to all current seniors, including those in Years 5 or 6.

## Timeline:

April 13 Senior teachers report Semester 2 grades of Passing (P) or Incomplete (I)

based on learning assessed before the March 13 closure.

April 14-30 Counselors will contact all seniors to discuss their individualized learning plan.

TBA Delayed or Virtual Commencement Ceremonies

August 31 Deadline for Class of 2020 to meet graduation requirements.

#### **Career Education Credit:**

This requirement has been suspended by ODE.

- This will be awarded to all seniors based on their 9-12 experience.
- No further work is needed on Senior Project or other requirements.

#### **Essential Skills:**

- This requirement has been suspended by ODE.
- No further work is needed on Essential Skills.

#### **Grading:**

- Seniors will be awarded a Passing (P) mark if they were earning an A-D as of March 13.
- Seniors will be awarded an Incomplete (I) if they were not earning at least a D as of March 13.
  These students will be allowed to continue their coursework in order to demonstrate enough
  proficiency to earn a Passing (P) mark on the curriculum taught and assessed before March
  13th.
- Grade Point Average (GPA) will not be impacted by either a Pass (P) or Incomplete (I). Incompletes will not be converted to Fs for Spring 2020 grades.

### **Next Steps for Students:**

Options for seniors who earned an "I" in any class as of April 13th:

- > If the class is not needed for graduation credit, seniors may withdraw without penalty. The course will be removed from the transcript.
- > If the class is needed for graduation credit, seniors will stay in the class until a passing mark is earned.
- ➤ If the class is needed for graduation credit and the student is transferring to a BSD Flex course, the teacher will provide seniors and counselors a summary of the learning targets that need to be met.

Options for seniors who will have met graduation requirements as of April 13th:

- ➤ Discontinue any course in which they were awarded a Passing (P) mark (but will remain in Synergy).
- ➤ Continue courses in which they were awarded a Passing (P) mark through June 5th. Teachers will provide feedback and support, however no additional grades will be awarded.
- ➤ Continue Dual Credit courses. While the college transcript may reflect a letter grade, the BSD transcript will reflect a Passing (P) mark.
- ➤ Continue AP courses in order to prepare for AP Exams. College Board Updates for AP Students
- ➤ Continue IB courses to complete requirements for IBO. <u>IBO Updates for DP and CP Students</u>

Options for seniors who will not have met graduation requirements as of April 13th:

➤ Counselors will work with students to develop a credit recovery pathway. Students have until August 31st to complete work to graduation with the Class of 2020.
