HS Level 7 Standards and Benchmarks

The course is based firmly on the study of both language and literature. The main focus of this course is on the reinforcement and refinement of language skills, as distinct from language acquisition. Students will be given the opportunity to explore the cultures of the language and to make connections between other languages and cultures with which they are familiar. They will thus be able to use the language for purposes and in situations involving sophisticated discussion, argument and debate.
