SAFEGUARDING AND CHILD PROTECTION NOTICE – REMOTE LEARNING

St Christopher's School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children. As such we expect all staff, volunteers and visitors to share this common commitment.

What to do if you're worried about a pupil:

If you feel that a child may be at risk of harm, then inform one of the safeguarding team as soon as possible. They will offer advice and take appropriate action. If you are concerned a child may be at risk of significant or immediate harm, this should be raised with the team **immediately** and **in person (which will need to be over the phone while remote learning is in place)**.

Child abuse can happen to any child regardless of elements such as gender, culture, religion, social background ability or disability. A copy of the school's safeguarding policy is available on the school website.
