

# Kindergarten eLearning Guide – MUSIC – Week 5

## Objectives

- The students will move to and identify the steady beat.
- The students will create sound effects.
- The students will listen and move to a song.
- The students will label so and mi.
- The students will identify how many sounds are on a beat.

Beginning the week of April 14, and in alignment with our Adjusted Grading Guidelines, teachers in grades PK-5 will be monitoring progress of students in a variety of ways.

## For Parents

- **WHAT SHOULD I DO TO HELP MY CHILD?**
  - Guide your child through the following activities and support your child as needed. Help them locate the videos and tools on the website.

## For Students

- **Activity #1** - Song # 29 “I Get a Happy Feeling” - Watch the Lyrics video to learn the song. Practice keeping the beat by following the words of the song. Tap the beat over your heart, by clapping your hands, and by stomping your feet. Try pointing to the beat using the beat chart in the Additional Resources section below.
- **Activity #2** - Song #133 “Rain Rain” - Watch the Lyrics video to learn the song. Watch the Story video and see if you can find the words that make sound effects. Watch the Kids Demo video to learn how to add movements and the song to the story. Perform with the video for your family. In the “Interactive Activities” box, click the Interactive Solfa button to practice labeling your higher and lower sounds (so and mi) and the Interactive Rhythm button to practice finding how many sounds are on a beat.
- **Activity #3** - Song #135 “If All the Raindrops” - Watch the Lyrics video to learn the song and then sing along. Can you make up your own movements to act out the song? Try creating a new verse of your own.
- **Activity #4** - Song #136 “Ame Ame” - Watch the Lyrics video and listen to the song. This song is in Japanese and is about rain. As you listen and sing the song, can you tell that the song is meant to sound like raindrops? Try finding some objects in your home that make sounds like raindrops and play along with the rhythm (the way the words go) of the song.
