

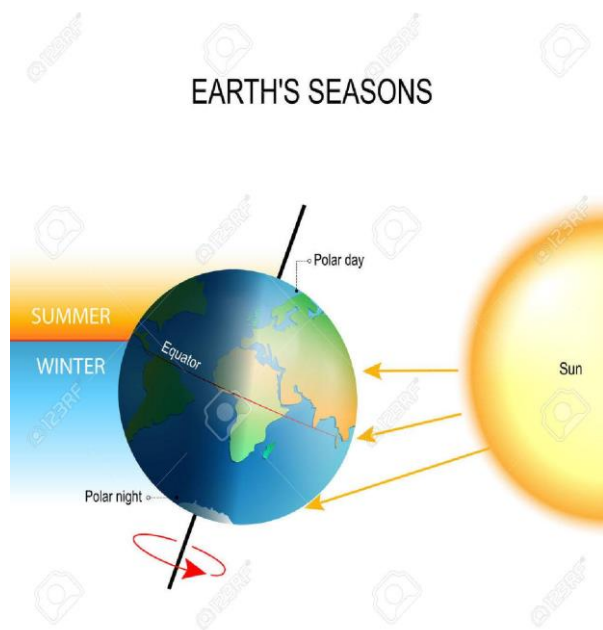

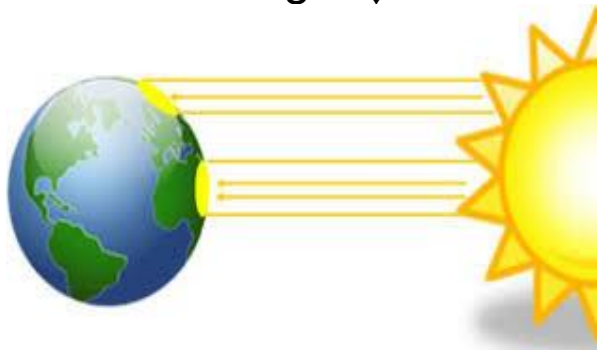
Earth

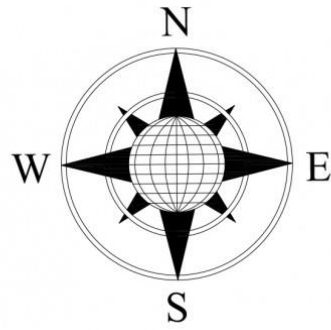
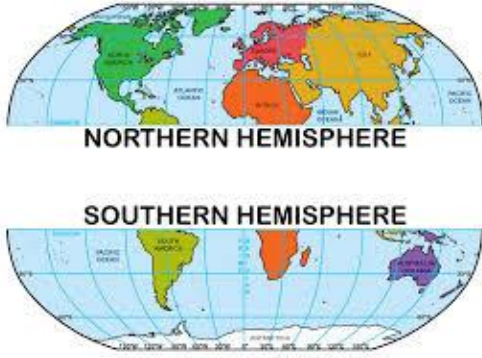
Indirect Sunlight ↓

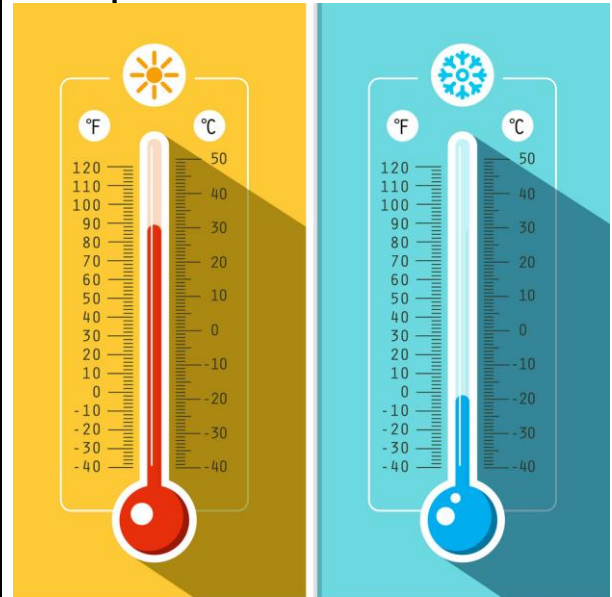
