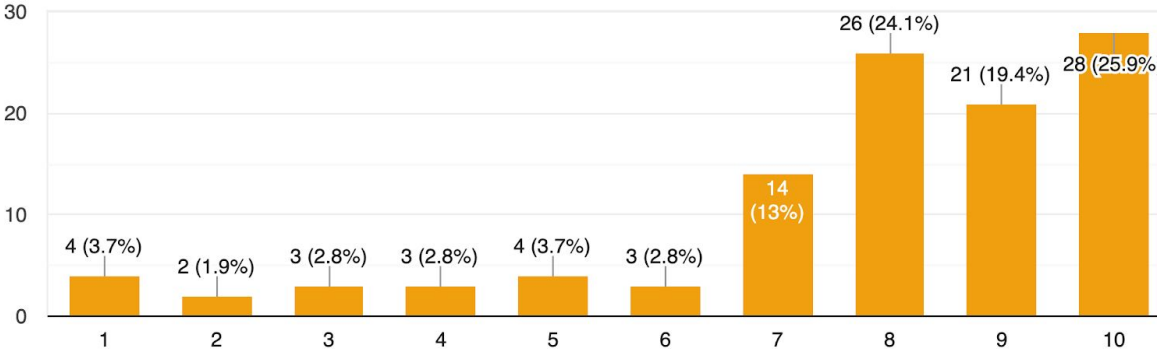

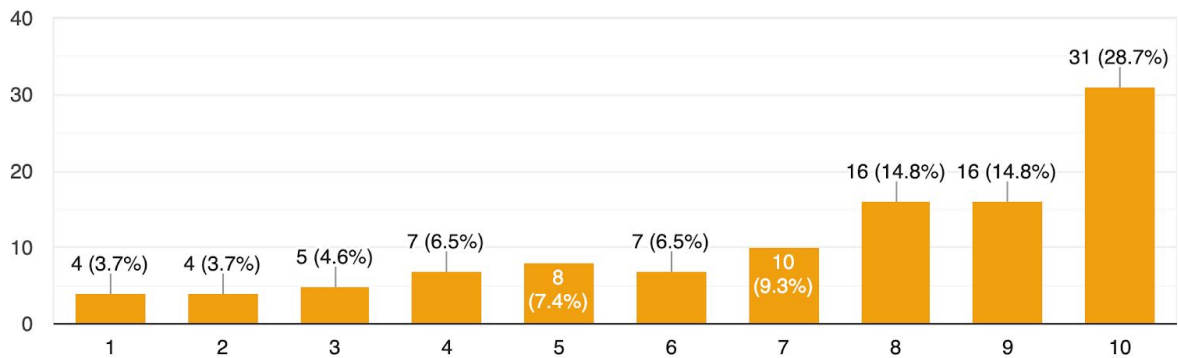

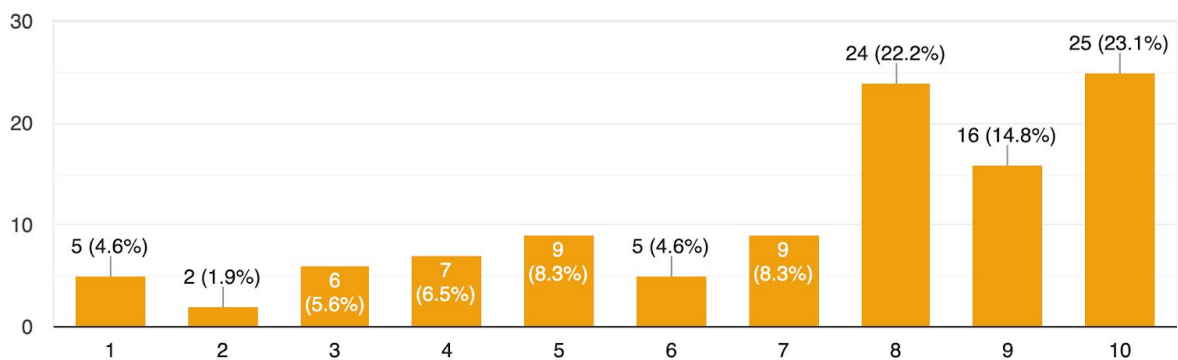
a. What level of satisfaction have you found with the DLP in general?



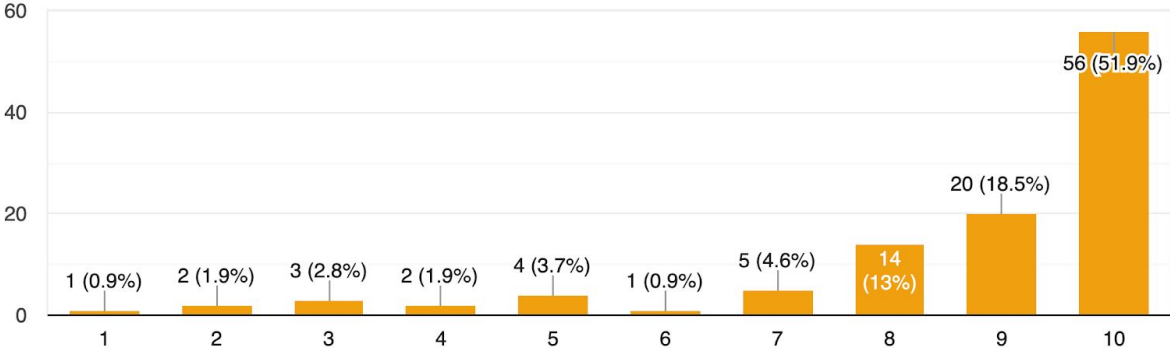
b. How realistic have the expectations been for your children regarding the amount of time spent completing their work and their responsibilities with distance learning?
