

5 • How will YES Prep grade equitably during closure?

Closing out A5 (February 18th - April 3rd, 2020)

Closing Out A5: Policy

- For A5, grades will be finalized based on assignments completed prior to Spring Break.
- No grades on assignments completed after March 12 will be assessed for A5.
- Assignments not completed during A5 will be excused. Any assignments that **could have** been reassessed will be graded at a 70, if the original grade was a 69 or below.
- You can check grades in the <u>Home Access Center</u> at any time.

During A6 (April 6th - May 22nd, 2020)

Grading During Keep YES Prep Learning: Policy

- For A6, students will receive equally-weighted, achievement-based grades on assignments based on the mini-lessons in each class.
- Grades in A6 can only improve students' scores for the semester; as such, we encourage students to correct their work, but we will not offer graded reassessment opportunities. Common Assessment 2 will still count as 7% of the semester grade, with the exception of courses that did not test prior to closure.
- We are currently studying the potential impacts of GPA. Our goal is to make a decision that is in the best interest of our students and their college access. We will update this document once we have made a decision.

Grading During Keep YES Prep Learning for Students in Special Populations: Policy

- For students in special populations, students will be graded on assignments on the same timeline in A6 and only on assignments with the appropriate accommodations, modifications, and supports.
- Grades in A6 can only improve students' scores for the semester; as such, we encourage students to correct their work, but we will not offer graded reassessment opportunities.

Keep YES Prep Learning AP Decisions

How will YES Prep ensure that all AP students are able to be successful in Spring 2020 AP Testing?

Expectations for Testing

Policy:

At YES Prep we expect all students to take the AP exam for courses they are enrolled in to increase their college readiness.

Rationale and Additional Information:

- All AP exams will be 45 minutes long and will be taken at home, virtually.
- An updated YES Prep testing schedule can be found <u>here</u>. Makeup testing is available in certain circumstances.
- All exams will be taken at home using any devices at hand, including a personal mobile phone, and will be open book/open note.
- YES Prep is working to close technology gaps to be sure all students can be successful on their AP exams.
- All exams will be protected by digital security tools to prevent cheating.

On AP Fees

Policy:

YES Prep families will not be required to pay any outstanding or unpaid AP testing fees for Spring 2020.

On AP Test Preparation

Policy:

The Keep YES Prep Learning Program will ensure students are prepared for the exams.

Rationale and Additional Information:

- AP students will complete 3 assignments per course per week to prepare for the AP exam.
- AP students must log-in to AP Classroom in advance of the testing date to ensure they have access to the exam.
- AP students will participate in a synchronous (live) practice opportunity before the exam.
- AP students can use the <u>Live and on-demand AP Resources to get additional practice</u>.
