## COVID-19 - Digital Learning FAQ



### **Will we still have a graduation ceremony?**

Yes! We will have a Virtual Graduation on May 22, 2020, at 8:00 PM.

We have plans to hold a traditional, face-to-face graduation ceremony on August 1, 2020.

### **What about my cap and gown? Diploma?**

Once the shelter in place order expires, we will email Seniors a time to pick up their cap and gown.

Diplomas will be distributed after the August 1, 2020, graduation ceremony. In the event of cancellation, a pickup date and procedure will be announced.

### **Will we still have Prom?**

Due to COVID-19 social distancing restrictions and the President's new phased plan for reopening events, our traditional Junior/Senior Prom for 2020 has been canceled.

We are planning a special Celebration for Seniors and their dates on July 31, 2020, in place of Prom.

### **What if I've already bought my Prom ticket?**

Junior Prom tickets will be valid for the 2021 Prom, so you are ahead of the game!

Senior Prom tickets will be credited towards the Celebration of Seniors. If social distancing guidelines force the cancellation of the event, refunds will be granted to Seniors.

### **When will I get my yearbook? Letter jacket?**

Once the shelter in place order is lifted and these items are delivered to the school, we will communicate procedures for picking these items up.

### **How can I get my Certificate of Enrollment to obtain my learner's permit/driver's license?**

Once the shelter in place order is lifted, students should email [ebennett@rabuncountyschools.org](mailto:ebennett@rabuncountyschools.org) to request a Certificate of Enrollment. Emails must be received by Monday at noon. Forms will be available for pickup the following Friday at the Guard Shack between 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM.

### **When can I collect my things from school?**

Once the shelter in place order is lifted and social distancing guidelines relaxed, we will communicate a time and procedure for cleaning out lockers and collecting items from the school.

### **Is my Digital Learning work optional?**

All assigned Digital Learning work should be completed and turned in to your teachers no later than May 13, 2020. You are expected to communicate any questions or concerns directly with your teachers. May 14 - 22 will be set aside for additional help as needed.

### **What if my Chromebook stops working?**
