- 1. The numbers 4 and 6 are the **factors** of 4×6 .
- 2. An example of a fact family is:
 - $2 \times 3 = 6$ $3 \times 2 = 6$ $6 \div 2 = 3$ $6 \div 3 = 2$
- 3. The number 24 is a **multiple** of the number 6.
- 4. The equations $6 \times 1 = 6$ and $15 \times 1 = 15$ are examples of the **Identity Property of Multiplication**.
