What happens when school starts

- ◆ University of Colorado offers 6 college credits for JROTC cadets (after junior year).
- ◆ A field trip to WLD Ranch in Girard, where cadets kick start the year by working together as a team in a variety of physically challenging events.
- ◆ Orientation Flights available to spark interest in aviation careers, at no cost.
- ◆ Beginners Military Marching Team competes against over 20 schools during the year
- ◆ Flags are presented at sporting events at the national level and also area events
- ◆ Unique field trips: major military installations, camping trips, museum trips, and obstacle courses.
- ◆ Academic and Computer teams take on schools from around the world
