Terms and Features	<ul> <li>Me Space = Blue bar along the left and top. This area is used to navigate around Teams.</li> <li>We Space = Collaborative area in the middle of the Teams window. Information and content here are generally visible to everyone that is part of the Team.</li> <li>Channel = A way to organize different Tabs (Files, Posts, and teacher-created content) around a topic. Join a Teams Call	<ul> <li>If your teacher sent a calendar invite to a meeting:</li> <li>Select Calendar on the left side of the app to see your meetings. Find the meeting you want, and then select Join.</li> </ul>	Calendar
