Requirements:

The scholarship:

A one-time payment of \$1,500 awarded to an individual meeting the requirements and selected based on the following essay questions. There is a 250-word maximum per question.

1. Tell me about someone who has inspired you to become the person you are today.
2. Tell me about your greatest accomplishment.
