

## Regents' and New Century Scholarship updates

### 2020 HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES

- Students who are current applicants must complete all requirements, including completion of courses for the scholarship.
- Students can earn a pass or “P” grade and still meet the cumulative GPA and credit requirements for both Regents’ and New Century Scholarship programs.
- Students will receive a status notification in their online account starting mid-April extending through May.
- **Please pass the following information to your school registrar:** We STRONGLY encourage official transcripts be sent via electronic transcript exchange (e.g. Parchment or National Student Clearinghouse). If your school does not use an electronic transcript exchange service, transcripts must be sent by the registrar through secure email directly to the USHE Scholarship Office to the respective email accounts ([regentsschoalrship@ushe.edu](mailto:regentsschoalrship@ushe.edu) or [newcentury@ushe.edu](mailto:newcentury@ushe.edu)) under the following conditions:
  - Transcripts must be sent through a secure method, directly from school staff, in compliance with data security protocols for student information. Contact your IT department to learn how to send secure emails to protect student information.
  - Transcripts need to be signed (an e-signature or stamp is acceptable) by the appropriate staff member then saved as a PDF. If possible, save the document in the following naming format: Lastname\_firstname\_mm/dd/yyyy\_Nameofhighschool. Note: the date is the date the transcript is sent.
  - The day we receive the email will be considered the postmarked date.
  - If transcripts are mailed, students can expect significant processing delays.
