□ Findings

- District has a robust method for assessing enrollment and capacity for the 10-year horizon
- District has engaged an external demographer to perform enrollment projections
- District has witnessed rapid growth and it will continue

□ Findings

- Portables are aging and costs to install portables are high
- New classrooms need to be built to accommodate growth
- Land parcels appropriate for building new schools are scarce

Recommendations

District build new schools at the mid-range investment level to address lack of classroom capacity
