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## □ Findings

- ➔ District has a robust method for assessing enrollment and capacity for the 10-year horizon
- ➔ District has engaged an external demographer to perform enrollment projections
- ➔ District has witnessed rapid growth and it will continue

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## □ Findings

- ➔ Portables are aging and costs to install portables are high
- ➔ New classrooms need to be built to accommodate growth
- ➔ Land parcels appropriate for building new schools are scarce

## □ Recommendations

- ➔ District build new schools at the mid-range investment level to address lack of classroom capacity
